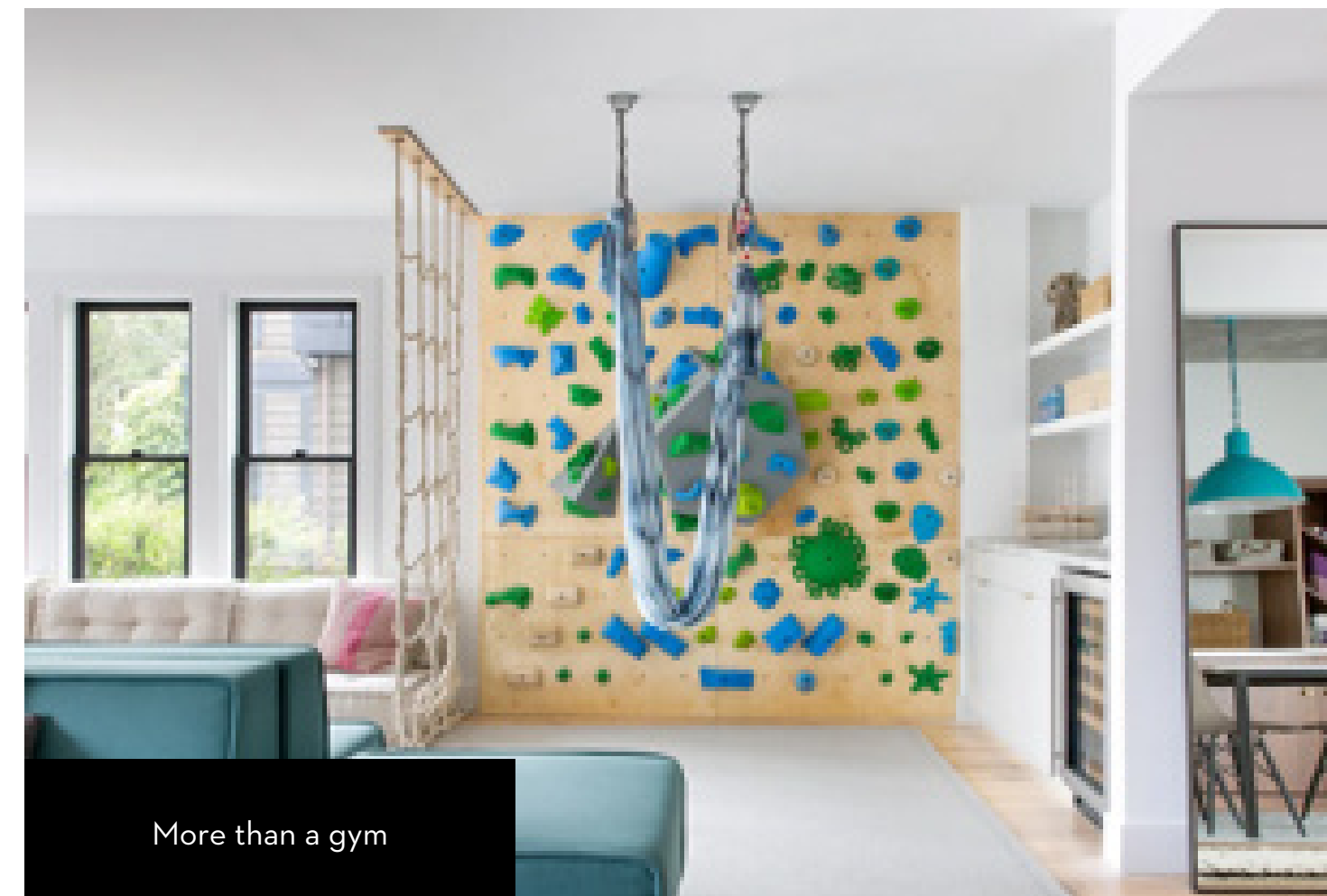
Wellness Redefined

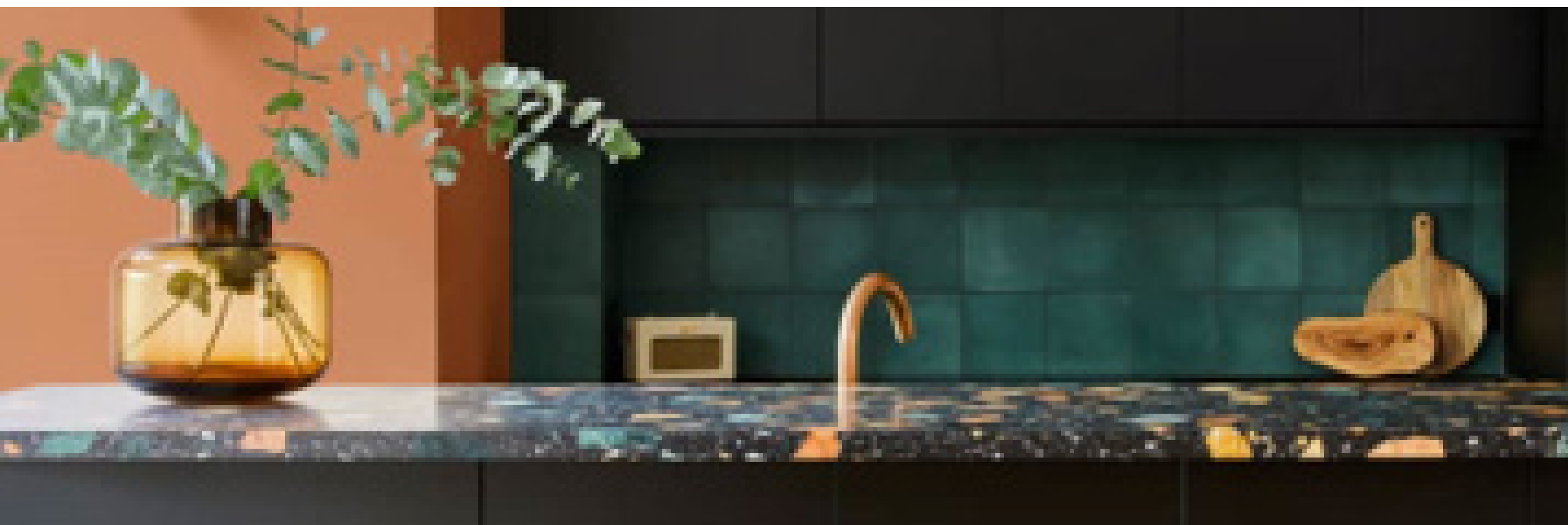
Juxtaposition

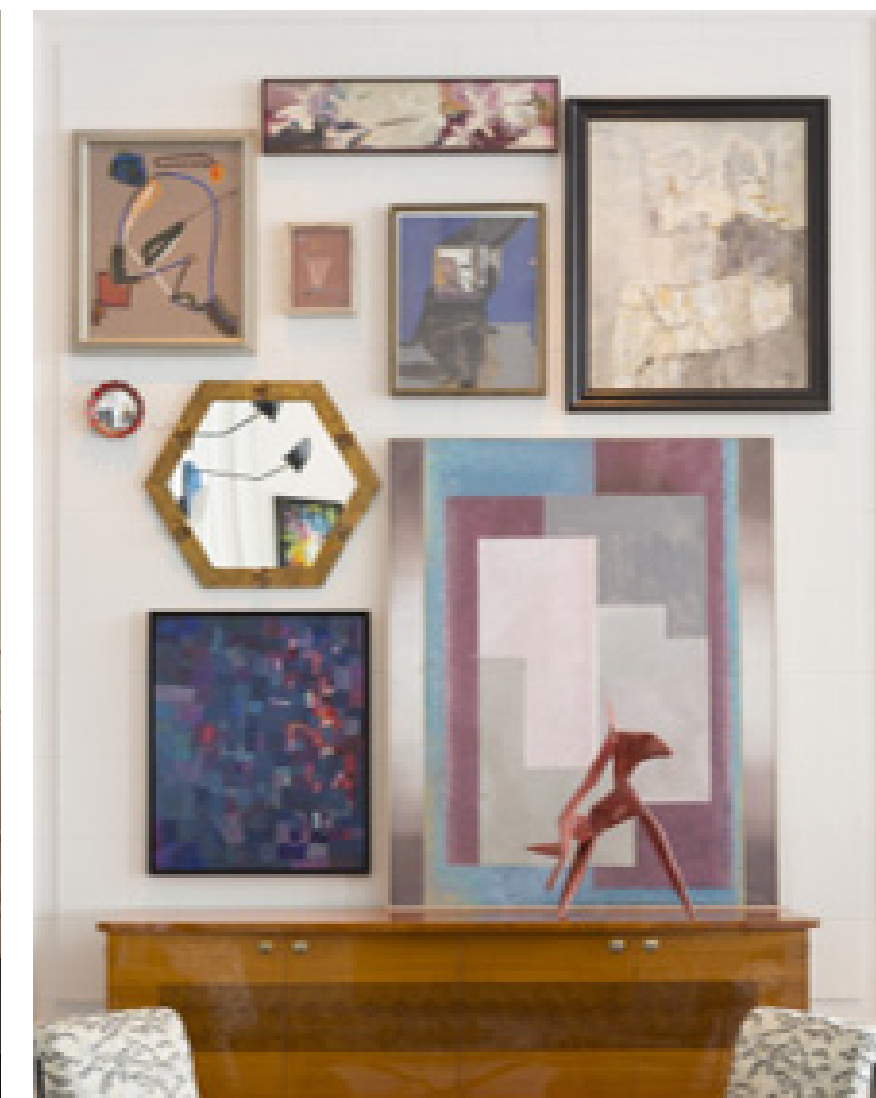
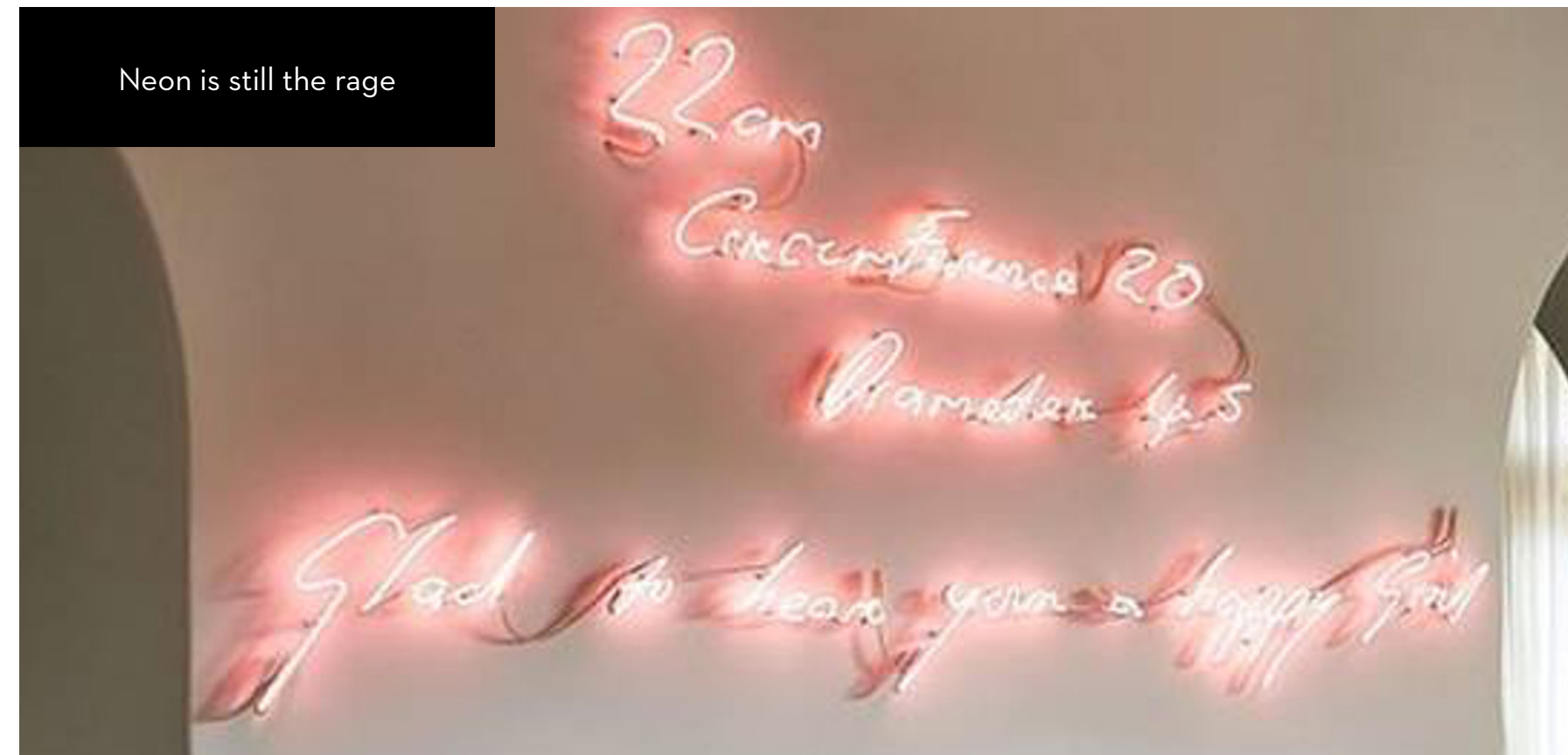
